SUMMARY

The Install and Service Technician is responsible for installing, with or without direct supervision, Access Control devices such as Card Readers, Request to Exit Buttons, Motion Sensors, Magnetic locks, Electric Door Strikes, Access Control Panels, Power Supplies, various electronic components, and various cable that includes but is not limited to: twisted pair cable, coax, power limited tray cable, stranded cable and solid conductor low voltage cable. Cable installation includes: placement, termination, testing, labeling and documentation. The Technician performs associated duties in the field and shop, delivers supplies and maintains pertinent records as required. This position requires a highly motivated, detail-oriented individual with good work ethic and great customer service skills.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Including, but not limited to the following:

Install and service various electronic equipment.

Program Access Control Panels and Systems and other systems related to audio and video.

Install cable pathway systems (cable trays, cable racks, J-hooks or D-rings).

Install, terminate, test, label and document horizontal, backbone and other cables.

Dress and route into closets and control room.

Firestop and various types of cable penetrations.

Follow safety practices to safeguard against injury and damage to property.

Safeguard against loss of unused materials, ladders, and tools on a job site or office location.

Clean up debris from installation, patch drill holes, and return unused materials.

Perform other duties as required.
